A first place trophy will be awarded to team champions. Plaques will be awarded to runner-up and first runner-up.

High school entry fee: Men \$75.00 per team, Women \$75.00 per team and \$10.00 per individual.

University entry fee: Men \$200.00 per team, Women \$200.00 per team and \$10.00 per individual. This year all entry fees must accompany your entries or your team will not be permitted to compete.

ENTRY FEES

High school entry fee: Men \$75.00 per team, Women \$75.00 per team and \$10.00 per individual.

University entry fee: Men \$200.00 per team, Women \$200.00 per team and \$10.00 per individual. This year all entry fees must accompany your entries or your team will not be permitted to compete.

SCHEDULE

Athletes must check in at the clerking area prior to the start of their events or they will be scratched. The announcer will make a first call for all competitors and a final call. The meet will operate off of a rolling schedule. Once the meet starts, the events will run in order. It is very important that you and your athletes pay close attention to announcements and the flow of the meet to avoid any missed check-ins. Please be mindful of when your event is. **Do not depend on the hearing of calls.**

FIELD EVENTS

Field events will operate off of the given time schedule. There will be 4 attempts given. All competitors' first measurable jump or throw will be measured for verification of competing. However, any jump or throw after the first that does not meet the Meets measuring standards will not be measured. The meets measuring standards will be determined based on entries. All competitors will be notified prior to the start of the event.

EVENT LIMITATION

Four individual per event and 2 relays per event per school.

Spike length will be 1/4" maximum. **No Christmas tree spikes or pins.** Spikes will be checked. Starting blocks will be furnished.
